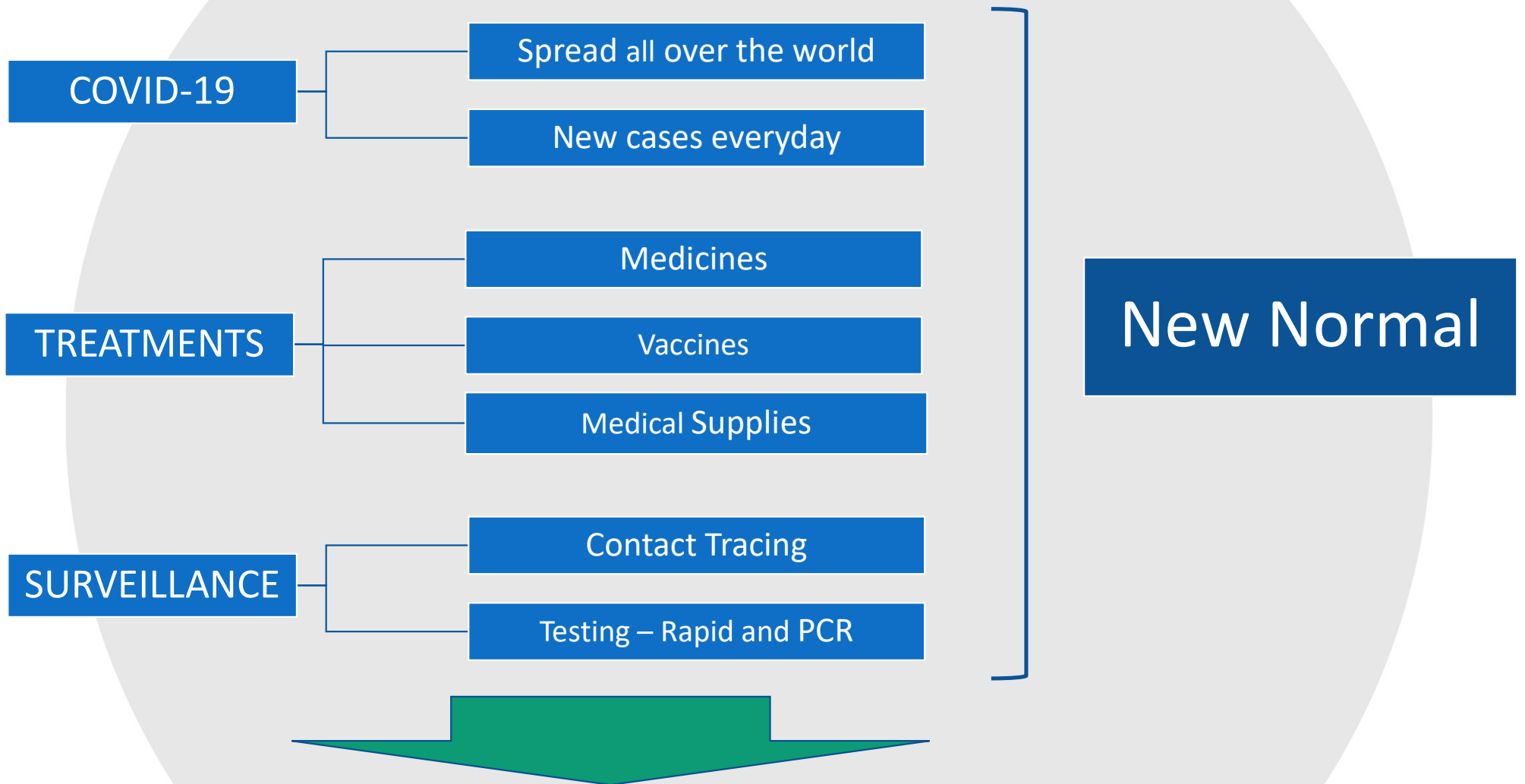

Our Experience

- We started to treat Covid-19 patients in the first week of March 2020.
- Referral is at that moment difficult due to limited capacity in the designated referral hospital.
- We convert several rooms to negative pressure rooms.
- At one given moment we have to treat more than 20 inpatient cases.
- Staff has to cope with a new way to take care of the patients due to the specific conditions.
- In the early phase limited supply of PPE, Medicine are a big obstacle.

What we do as related to “ The New Normal”

- Initiate body temperature screening in all hospital entrance, person with a body temperature more than 37.3° C will not be permitted to enter and will escorted to A&E unit for further evaluation.
- Rearrange inpatients placement so that COVID-19 patient is treated in a dedicated area in the 5th floor with negative pressure rooms.
- Designated nursing team and doctors are assigned to provide the necessary care to the patients, including lab. Technician, physical therapist, Radiology technician etc.
- Mandatory use of Face Mask and Hand Washing is implemented. Use of PPE is on as needed based on the current guidelines.
- Increase frequency of Cleaning and disinfecting all areas within the hospital, including cleaning and replacement of filters on all Air Handling Units.

- Implement and maintain social distancing in all patient areas and staff working areas,
- Implement work from home policy for non medical, non nursing staff and non allied health staff.
- Improve isolation facility in the ER.
- Do a baseline covid-19 rapid testing screening for all hospital staff and initiate self isolation for those who tested positive for 14 days.
- Do a surveillance on all staff* that work in the isolation room or are in close contact with Covid-19 patients and do a rapid test rescreening.
