NAVIGATING ECONOMIC CURRENTS WITH DANANTARA INDONESIA

Jakarta, July 3, 2025 — The global trade environment has been significantly shifted, particularly the dynamic of fiscal policies, by global developments, with both challenges and opportunities emerging in trade and investment. To unpack the ongoing global tariff tensions and their implications for Indonesia's economic resilience and investment appeal, the SwissCham Indonesia Fiscal, Customs, and Excise sectoral group organized a discussion with Danantara Investment Agency, as a key player in Indonesia's economic future with significant potential for global investors.



During the discussion, Ambassador of Switzerland to Indonesia, Timor-Leste, and ASEAN, H.E. Olivier Zehnder, commended Indonesia's planned reform efforts. His Excellency highlighted the bilateral trade, which reached CHF 2.1 billion in 2024, and Swiss investments that have exceeded USD 1.2 billion over the past five years, creating more than 20,000 local jobs. It reflects strong future potential to grow, especially under the Indonesia-EFTA CEPA.


Mr. Pandu Sjahrir, Chief Investment Officer of Danantara Indonesia, remarked in the forum that the current geopolitical and tariff dynamics present an opportunity for Indonesia to diversify its investment and funding landscape. RENEWABLE ENERGY - THE NEXT FRONTIER How Nuclear Energy is Entering Indonesia's Grid



Energy transitions are rarely immediate. They are shaped by constraints, guided by long-term thinking, and tested by uncertainty. Indonesia's latest electricity roadmap outlined in the RUPTL 2025–2034, reflects such a transition through deliberate restructuring rather than sweeping declarations.

Renewable energy is variable by nature. Its success in the system depends on a stable, dispatchable complement. Historically, this role has been filled by coal. In a lower-emission future, nuclear becomes a logical candidate.



Indonesia possesses measurable reserves of uranium (5,234 tons) and thorium (4,729 tons), mostly concentrated in Bangka Belitung and West Kalimantan. While extraction and refinement remain complex, these figures justify early-stage exploration. Still, the decision to proceed with nuclear is not based solely on technical viability. It rests on institutional capability.

Before construction can begin, several preconditions must be satisfied. Chief among them is the formation of a Nuclear Energy Program Implementation Organization (NEPIO)- an entity designed to coordinate policy, ensure compliance with international standards, and align stakeholders under a unified development framework. As of mid-2025, the draft presidential decree to establish NEPIO is awaiting approval. Once operational, NEPIO will function as the program's strategic centre - managing oversight, liaising with the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA), and setting the pace of rollout.




In recent months, Ambassador Olivier Zehnder and his team have participated in several key
